ORIGINS OF HIRAGANA: PART 1

All of the symbols of the *hiragana* are derived originally from Chinese characters. Here are the original Chinese characters from which each *hiragana* developed and their three different styles of penmanship. In each group, the first column on the left shows the modern *kana* symbol; the second column shows the *kanji* from which that *kana* was derived, with the *kanji* written in KAISHO style (regular style); the third column shows the same *kanji* in GYOOSHO style (walking style); and the fourth column shows the *kanji* in SOOSHO style (grass style).
